



- Cognate languages derived from indoeuropean
- Cognate languages derived from LATIN. Pay attention: sanskrit isn't cognate of latin, but derives from indo-iranian.
- Cognate languages derived from anglo saxon. Pay attention: english isn't cognate of german, but derives from anglosaxon.
- Actually, **LATIN** was only one of a number of Italic dialects (among which were Oscan and Umbrian), and some time passed before Latin won out over the other dialects in Italy. Similarly, among the Greeks there were a number of dialects (Aeolic, Attic, Ionic, Doric)
- The red line indicates the influences of Latin (and French) on English.
